In 1939 there was a ceremony dedicating, and publicly naming, the Kerr Project (named after Frank Kerr, then President of the Montana Power Company).

Many Confederated Salish and Kootenai Tribal Members were present during this ceremony. Energy Keepers, Inc., has been using one photo that was taken that day:
